

Since its opening in 1927, <u>Hotel New Grand</u> has been witness to the history of the exotic port city of Yokohama as Japan's leading hotel.

Many historic figures have visited the Main Building, which remains unchanged from 1927, including General MacArthur, Charlie Chaplin, and Babe Ruth. From the guest rooms, restaurants, and banquet halls in the Tower adjacent to the Main Building, you can enjoy spectacular panoramic views of the port of Yokohama, such as the Bay Bridge, Osanbashi Pier, and the night view of the Minato Mirai district.

The main building is recognized as a historical property in Yokohama City due to the beautifully maintained lobby, banquet hall, and other facilities.

Many dramas and movies have also featured the grand staircase connecting the first and second floors of the main building.

Yokohama Port is a short distance away from the Hotel New Grand, making it convenient for cruise passengers.

On the ground floor of the hotel, you can order a special cocktail from Bar Sea Guardian II to enjoy a night that is unique to Yokohama.

A hotel called "Urban Oasis" is known to be one of the best places to relax. Located in the center of Minatomirai, The Yokohama Bay Hotel Tokyu overlooks a park full of greenery and Yokohama Port. The hotel is across from Cosmo Clock 21, the Ferris wheel symbolizing the "Minato Mirai district". Minatomirai Station is walking-distance from the hotel, a very convenient location in the city. Most of the 480 guest rooms have balconies where you can feel the breeze from the harbor. There are some rooms that overlook cherry blossom trees blooming in spring. During the stay at the Luxury Ocean Twin, you can see the Bay Bridge from the bedroom with a calming feeling, as well as the Ferris Wheel from the bathroom through attractive large windows.

All-day dining "Cafe Tosca" overlooks the Minatomirai Ferris wheel, offers French cuisine, "Queen Alice" as if you were lost in "wonderland", Japanese cuisine "Oshima" is also served here, and Chinese Restaurant "szechwan restaurant CHEN" was opened in July 2021, etc...They offer a variety of options for you to choose from.
